

**Visual Art (P-12)**  
Teacher Licensure Requirements

Program Requirements

Gen Ed: Satisfactory completion of all general education requirements (generally 55 sem hrs).

Major: Satisfactory completion of a major in art (42 sem hours) with additional licensure requirements (8 sem hrs) as described below.

Education: Satisfactory completion of a minor in education (33 sem hours) as described below.

*Advising Note: Beginning with the class of 2010, all courses in the teaching field must be passed with grades of C- or higher. See the Academic Catalog for additional requirements for admission and continuance in the program. Courses may not be offered every year. Be sure to check with the department for schedule of course offerings.*

(*Advising Note: This elective can be used to partially satisfy the Studio Art Concentration requirement, e.g.: for a ceramics concentration.*)

\_\_\_ Art 490 Independent Study: Methods for Teaching Art P-12 (4) (*Advising Note: Offered fall semester odd-numbered years.*)

### Student Teaching
