Program Requirements

- Gen Ed: Satisfactory completion of all general education requirements (generally 55 sem hrs).

Student Teaching

Ten to twelve weeks of full-time student teaching is scheduled for the remainder of the term. Other coursework, if taken, must be scheduled for late afternoon or evenings during the term.
