**ALL-NCAC BASEBALL SQUAD ANNOUNCED;
FRANK, MOTT EARN TOP HONORS**

May 15, 2003

CLEVELAND -- Wooster sophomore third baseman **Jake Frank (Wooster, OH/Northwestern)** and Ohio Wesleyan junior righthander **Tyler Mott (Grove City, OH/Grove City)** have been named Player and Pitcher of the Year to highlight the 2003 All-North Coast Athletic Conference baseball selections.

Frank, last spring's NCAC Newcomer of the Year, is making his second straight appearance on the first team. This season he hit .434 (62-143) with 11 home runs and a conference-leading 62 runs batted in for the Fighting Scots. Frank ranks in the league's top five in four other categories: hits (62), runs scored (50), home runs (11) and total bases (113). His RBI total stands as the seventh-most during a single-season in Wooster history. Frank's .790 slugging percentage ranks as the ninth-highest at Wooster, and his .532 on-base percentage, fueled by 33 walks, is currently the third-best all-time in Scot annals.

Mott led the conference with an 11-0 record and a 1.97 earned-run average. As a junior, he has earned a total of five All-NCAC nods in three years. He is appearing on the first team for the second straight year as a pitcher after earning second-team honors as a freshman in 2001. He is appearing on the first team as a first baseman for the first time after earning second team honors last spring at third base. Mott hit .401 (57-142) with seven homers and 51 runs batted in for the Bishops.

Ohio Wesleyan senior outfielder **Joe Loudenslager (Hilliard, OH/Darby)** heads up the list of the remaining first-team selections. He makes his third straight appearance on the first team and was a second-team selection as a freshman. In all, five players are repeat selections to the first team. Bishop senior **Bo Burnett (Powell, OH/Olentangy)** and Wooster junior **Matt Miller (Millersburg, OH/Hiland)** all appear on the first squad for the second straight season.

Four players moved up from the second team. Allegheny senior **Josh Sharpless (Freedom, PA/Freedom)**, Wooster senior **Dave Wernecke (State College, PA/State College Area)** and Denison juniors **Adam Mandel (St. Louis, MO/MICDS)** and **Brian Regan (Cincinnati, OH/Anderson)** all make their first team debut after stints on the second team. Kenyon senior **Jesse Gregory (Gainesville, FL/Eastside)** and Big Red junior **Cam Cowden (Zionsville, IN/Zionsville)** both jump to the first team after earning honorable mention awards.

Wooster freshman pitcher **Jon Oliver (West Chester, OH/Lakota West)** was named Newcomer of the Year - the second straight Scot to win the award. Oliver compiled an 8-2 record with a 3.91 earned run average.

Ohio Wesleyan's **Roger Ingles** earned Coach of the Year honors for the fourth time after leading the Bishops to a 29-15 record entering this weekend's NCAA regional tournament, hosted by Ohio Wesleyan. He has an overall record of 597-267-7 for a winning percentage of .689 in 20 years as head coach of the Bishop program.
