Alma's Brehm, Mount Union's Kmic and Garcon, plus Wheaton's Studebaker Highlight 2006 Football Gazette's North All-Region Team

NORTH AURORA, Illinois -- Michigan Intercollegiate Athletic Association MVP, **Josh Brehm**, from Alma College, Ohio Athletic Conference "Most Outstanding Receiver Award" recipient, **Pierre Garcon**, and teammate and dynamic ground gainer, **Nate Kmic** from Mount Union College, along with College Conference of Illinois-Wisconsin "Outstanding Defensive Player" of the Year beneficiary, **Andy Studebaker**, headline a talented 2006 *Don Hansen's Football Gazette NCAA Division III North All-Region team*. Capital University's **Jim Collins** was name North Region Coach of the Year after leading the Crusaders' to the NCAA Div. III playoffs for Capital's second straight appearance, while finishing with an overall record of 11-2 for the season.

Brehm was announced as the Offensive Back of the Year, while Kmic proclaimed the Special Teams Player of the Year Award and teammate Garcon was acknowledged the Receiver of the Year. Studebaker earned Defensive Lineman of the Year accolades. Senior **Tom Brew** from Case Western Reserve University was designated the Defensive Back of the Year, and The College of Wooster's **Rick Drushal** garnered the Offensive Lineman of the Year award. Wilmington College's **Chad Otte** received the Defensive Back of the Year Honors.

Brehm, a senior, from Ithaca, Michigan, is the 2006 Michigan Intercollegiate Athletic Association Offensive MVP and the 2006 winner of the Gagliardi Trophy presented by Josten's to the Player of The Year in NCAA Division III. He led the NCAA in three categories, including total offense (4,084 yards), passing yards (3,448 yards) and passing yards per game (344.8 average). Tied an NCAA record by passing for 300 yards nine times this season, and has 21 career 300-yard passing games. Set NCAA record with 10 consecutive 300-yard total offense games this season, has 25 career 300-yard total offense games. Had eight consecutive games without an interception (set NCAA record with 288 pass attempts without an interception). Had 25 games with over 300 yards of total offense (10 consecutive this season). Led team to school records this season in passing yards (3,448), pass completions (305), touchdown passes (30) and points scored (382). Selected to participate in East Coast Bowl all-star game, Brehm completed 20-of-28 passes for 240 yards and one touchdown, while also rushing for a score. In 2006 he completed 305-of-462 passes (66.0 percent) for 3,448 yards and 30 touchdowns while being intercepted just three times. Brehm also rushed for 636 yards on 154 carries (4.1 yards per carry) and scored nine touchdowns.

Garcon, a junior, from West Palm Beach, Florida, was named the OAC's "Most Outstanding Receiver" for 2006. He is also an AFCA First Team All-American in 2006. Garcon caught 67 passes for 1,212 yards (18.1 yards per catch) and scored 17 touchdowns. He also had seven carries for 106 yards and two more scores, while returning three punts for 49 yards (16.3 average per return).

Kmic, a sophomore, from Delta, Ohio, is a First Team all-OAC pick in 2006. This past season he averaged 191.4 total offensive yards per game for his 15-0 National Champion Crusaders. Kmic had 336 carries for 2,365 yards and scored 26 touchdowns from his running back position. He also caught 20 passes for 173 yards and two scores, and returned 14 kickoffs for 333 yards (23.8 yards per return). Kmic averaged 7.76 yards every time he touched the ball.

Studebaker, a junior, from Congerville, Illinois, was voted the CCIW's "Outstanding Defensive Player" for 2006. He ended the season with the most quarterback sacks of any defensive player in Division III. He led the CCIW in tackles for loss and sacks, including setting Wheaton's single-season record for sacks. Studebaker also was credited with 19 quarterback hurries. His stats for 2006 were, 44 total tackles (28 solo), 24.5 tackles for loss (-161 yards), 17.5 sacks (-142 yards) and eight pass breakups. He was also named a 2006 AFCA First Team All-American.

Brew, a Senior, from Mentor, Ohio, was a 2006 Gagliardi Trophy Finalist, a University Athletic Association Co-Defensive Player of the Year and a First Team All-UAA honoree. He led the UAA in total tackles per game (12.1), while finishing 10th in NCAA Division III. Brew accomplished a rare feat in one game versus Denison, when his two solo tackles went for safeties. For the 2006 season he totaled 121 tackles, including 21.5 tackles for loss (-63 yards) with seven sacks (-24 yards). He also recorded three pass breakups and blocked three field goal attempts.

Drushal, a senior, from Lakeville, Ohio, is a 2006 AFCA First Team All-American, a three-time All-North Coast Athletic Conference First team selection, and was picked to play in the Aztec Bowl. He graded out at 86-percent with 116 knockdown blocks. He anchored an offensive line that allowed the offense to average 29.5 points per game, a five point improvement over the 2005 season. He started a school-record 42 games, all at left tackle. Drushal was a 2006 team captain.

Otte, a senior, from Maria Stein, Ohio, a First Team Ohio Athletic Conference pick, was chosen the OAC "Most Outstanding Defensive Back" for 2006. He totaled 84 tackles, including 1.5 tackles for loss (-7 yards) with one sack for minus six yards. Otte also broke up nine passes and made nine interceptions with 69 return yards, including one returned for a touchdown.

Jim Collins, led his players to a second-consecutive appearance in the NCAA Division III Championship Playoffs in 2006. His Crusaders' finished the 2006 campaign with an 11-2 mark. Both losses coming at the hands of the 2006 National Champions, Mount Union College, including a 17-14 loss in the quarterfinals of the playoffs. Collins' has guided the Crusaders for the past 10 seasons and has an overall record of 58-49 however, for the past six years he has a 49-17 record, including 21-5 the past two years at Capital's helm. Collins, enthusiasm, contagious attitude and strong work ethic are evident throughout the entire Capital football program but particularly in the offense for which he is offensive coordinator. Collins' teams have rewritten the school record books, setting 40 new records. As a football player at Wittenberg University, Collins, is still in the Tigers' record books as one of their top all-time wide receivers ranking third in career receptions (116) and fifth in career yards receiving (1,560). Collins has also written numerous articles on coaching and serves as the North Region chair of the NCAA Division III National Football Committee.
